On the Isnag Old Testament Checking and Revision

Since the pandemic lock down which started in March, *I have finished checking and revising 7 books of the Isnag Old Testament translation: Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1 Samuel, 2 Samuel, 1 Kings and 2 Kings.* This brings *the total percentage of the checked and revised Isnag OT translation to 81.83 %.* The remaining books are the history books and the minor prophets. I am currently checking and revising 1 Chronicles.

Other Activities

I finished checking the last revision of a passage in the New Testament of the Ayta Mag-Indi language. They have finished the audio recording of the entire New Testament, and should now be available to the Aytas.
